

The Sage Port HOA applied for and was awarded a matching federal grant for wildfire mitigation activities in the community. The time a property owner spends mitigating his/her property or the amount a property owner pays someone else to mitigate his/her property can qualify for matching funds. The funds can be used for community wildfire mitigation efforts such as: slash removal, community education, etc.

Examples of qualifying activities include:

- Clearing brush
- Trimming trees
- Clearing combustible materials from around your home
- Cleaning up downed branches, leaves and pine needles
- Installing non-flammable landscaping
- Amount paid to someone else to mitigate your property
- Time and/or money spent chipping, hauling, or disposing of slash
- Educational time - attending educational/informational meetings

Instructions: Property owner time and expense reporting

- Please provide:
  - ✓ Name of the property owner
  - ✓ Address information for the property
  - ✓ Telephone number (optional)
- For each qualifying activity, please provide:
  - ✓ date(s)
  - ✓ name of the person who did the work
  - ✓ brief description of the activity
  - ✓ number of hours or dollar amount spent
- Qualifying activities must occur between 10/01/2003 and 09/30/2005.
- In order to meet grant deadlines, please complete and submit forms by 08/31/2005.
